HUSBAND - Messach Meshick PITMAN

Picture and story about this family in Winter Quarters Remembered page 19, saying that the two youngest boys were kidnapped and taken into Canada, but the census shows a different story. Somehow this family ties in with the Thomas Naylor family. In the 1900 Winter Quarters census the two youngest boys who are now orphans are living with this family. They are listed as adopted sons. There is an ord sealing for Messach Pitman and a Sarah Ann Naylor in England before he married Mary Paterson. There are many children who are listed as Messach Pitman and Mary Ann Naylor who have the last name of Naylor. I am still confused. Headstone in Scofield Cemetery reads Mishach Pitman.

MII: He came with his parents and brother Daniel on the Wisconsin September 1877.

WIFE - Mary PATERSON

One ord record is an extracted birth record. Her parents are: John Paterson and Christina Robertson.

From date of death and date of birth and death of her last child she must have died from child birth comp. Film #484812 says she died of blood poisoning.

The Naylor's adopted her little children.

CHILD 2 - James Jim PITMAN

The Winter Quarters 1900 census has him living with a Great Aunt Sarah Langdon. The census gives his birth date as March 1892. His two little brothers are with the Naylor family listed as adopted sons.

James Pitman sued the PVCC on behalf of his brothers. They received \$500.00 less 33 taxes. Film #484812 pg 301. Thomas Parmley is listed a guardian of infants.
